

## National Minimum Wage 2010/11

The 2010/11 rates for the National Minimum Wage are:

- Adult rate (aged 21 and over) - £5.93
- Development rate (aged 18 - 20) - £4.92
- Lower rate (aged 16 - 17) - £3.64

The majority of UK employees are entitled to the National Minimum Wage (NMW) rates. Exemptions include:

- Volunteers
  - Self employed
  - Apprentices under the age of 19 or in their first year of apprenticeship
  - Workers based outside the UK including Isle of Mann and the Channel Islands
